Resident Story – Verlin 'Bob' Wiggers

Verlin 'Bob' Wiggers was born on February 23, 1940 to Earl and Louise (Teissen) Wiggers at Hesston, Kansas. His father was a carpenter and custodian and his mother was a homemaker. Verlin was the middle child - he had an older brother, Melbert and a younger sister, Luerla (Mrs. Dale Wenger). He grew up in the Hesston area and on a drive this summer to Hesston guided his driver to the place where they lived several blocks west of the pharmacy. He talked about playing in the baseball field across the street from the house. His father built this house after they moved from the country - he did this with one arm from haydite blocks. His dad had lost his arm due to polio. The nickname 'Bob' was given to him by his grandfather. On August 8, 1960 he married Naomi Ruth Schmidt from Hesston, Kansas. Together they raised their family of three boys and three girls. Lorretta (Mrs. John Jantz) lives in Galva, Kansas and the others are elsewhere. Vivian (Mrs. Darrel Penner) lives in Indiana and Anita (Mrs. Christian Stoltzfus) lives in Ohio. The sons are Milton who lives in Ohio; Gerald who lives in California; and Kendal who lives in Tennessee. Bob started working as a welder at Hesston Corporation at age 18. After moving to South Dakota he worked for Huron Manufacturing and was involved with the design and engineering of building finish grade/paving machines, including one that was shipped to Mozambique. Later he moved his own business from the shop near his home in Osceola to a new shop in Iroquois which was called Iroquois Manufacturing. Through the years Bob was involved with the design and production of various aspects of equipment including the 620 self-propelled swather, Grass Dragon lawnmowers, several types of skid steers (some of this design was acquired by Bobcat), a universal combine chaff spreader attachment, and a selfloading self-propelled feed wagon. After his wife passed away in 2007 he lived in a little cabin on his daughter's yard in Indiana and did a lot of welding and repair for the Amish. Bob moved to Pine Village in Moundridge before settling in here at the Manor in June 2020. He loves to start his day with a good cup of coffee. Through the years Bob has enjoyed painting scenery and drawing with colored pencils. He enjoys watching the birds at his bird feeder. On warm days Bob likes to go sit outside. Some favorite snacks are Reese's peanut butter cups and a Pepsi! Also, he likes popcorn and soft serve ice cream with chocolate syrup.
