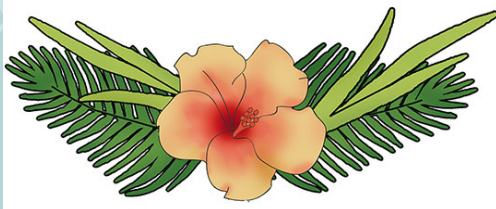

Resident Story – Twila Becker

I was born on August 18, 1933 to David J. and Hattie (Wedel) Schmidt at Fairview, Oklahoma. My dad was a farmer and carpenter. My mother was a housewife. My childhood days were spent in the Fairview area. I attended the Green Valley School where I was the only one in my grade. Later I attended the Fairview Consolidated School and graduated from the 8th grade in a class of 80 students! We were 40 students in each classroom. My favorite subject was geography. I am the second oldest in my family, with three brothers and 2 sisters. All of my siblings are deceased – Sylvia Jean lived 2 days; Larry Dean died when he was 29; also, there was Janora Kay, Hubert Lee and Darrel Don. I have many memories of my childhood like the time we used wax paper to get the 8-foot slide really slick - I fell from the top of the slide, broke my arm and dislocated my hip. Another memory was when I was getting off the school bus to walk home – I was wearing a wine-colored coat and got chased by two coyotes. I screamed and screamed – my mother Hattie heard me and thought the bull was after me. When she asked what was wrong, I couldn't talk – no sound came out! I was scared speechless! It was a little while before my voice came back. Some of my jobs were babysitting, house jobs and CNA work – first working at the Goessel hospital and later working at the Moundridge Manor until retiring at age 60. I met my husband, Arnold Duane Becker, at the Goessel hospital. His mom was there as a patient having surgery. We married April 28, 1957. Arnold was a farmer and carpenter. At first, we lived in Larned, Kansas where Arnold was in service. We then settled in the Galva community, later moving to Moundridge. We had five children: Kendall Lynn (Galva); Lamonty Ray (he only lived two days); Janet Colleen Kurtz, Pipestone, Minnesota; Delane Arlo (Canton) and Kayleen Renae Unruh (Galva). We have 14 grandchildren and 10 great-grandchildren. Arnold passed away on February 17, 2020. Special interests in my life were quilting – I quilted a quilt for each of my grandchildren and great-grandchildren, 12 quilts for a lady from Topeka and quilts for The Buttonhole in McPherson. Also, I enjoy making scrapbooks, writing letters and keeping a daily diary. Through the years I have enjoyed teaching Bible School and Sunday School and taking part in the Sewing Circle. I love Dutch cooking and a Dr. Pepper now and then hits the spot! I moved to the Manor on May 11, 2021 and am enjoying the social activity!

ACTIVITY INFORMATION

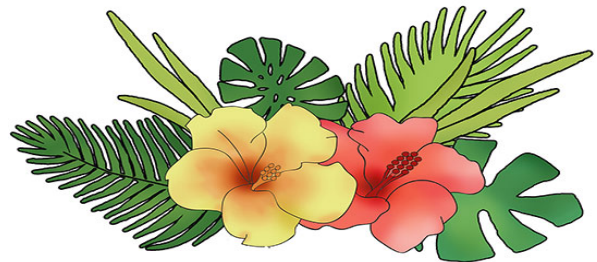
