Resident Story – Della Unruh

Della and her twin sister Donna were born to Pete and Viola (Dirks) Koehn on November 4, 1928 at home on a farm near Burrton, Kansas. They together with a younger sister Erma grew up in the Halstead, Kansas community. Della started school at the little country school named Fairview and finished her schooling in town at the Halstead schools. She married Joe Unruh on June 4, 1950; he also grew up at Halstead. They lived in Halstead awhile then moved to Scott City, Kansas in 1955 till 1956. They moved back to a place north of Halstead where they had a dairy and farmed. Later they moved into Joe's parents place west of Halstead. There children are Barbara, Tuscon, Arizona; Roy (Patricia), Halstead, Kansas; Verlin (deceased), Marlin (Raeletta), Halstead, Kansas; and Rochelle (Doyle) Becker, Pryor, Oklahoma. In October 1979, Verlin was killed in a tragic accident when the motorcycle he was driving collided with a combine after dark. Joe and Della were members of the Grace Mennonite Church at Halstead. Della enioved teaching Bible School while her children were growing up. They were custodians for the Halstead Public Schools for seventeen years. When they retired they built a new home in Halstead. Joe passed away in September 2010. Della has 14 grandchildren and 33 great-grandchildren with two more on the way. When her girls were growing up Della did a lot of sewing; now she enjoys reading. Della's twin sister passed away in 2004. Della moved to the Manor on July 29, 2020. Her sister Erma lives at Moundridge Manor and they enjoy sitting together at mealtime and playing Bingo across from one another.




